First Day :Day 1- Marsa Alam- Hurghada- Cairo

You will be transferred from your hotel at 00:00 by air-conditioned car from Marsa Alam to Hurghada airport. You will fly from Hurghada . It takes 02.30 minutes to drive to Hurghada airport from Marsa Alam . The Flight departs at 05:00 from Hurghada , Arrive at Cairo airport at 06:30 the flight takes 1 hour, you will be transferred with your tour guide to enjoy your Cairo tour,

We will start our tour by visiting Giza

The Pyramids of Giza (Cheops , Chephren, and Mykerinus . Then proceed to visit the Great Sphinx, which dates back to the time of and visit the Valley Temple .

Lunch will be served during the Pyramids at the local restaurant in Giza

Then visit the Egyptian Museum

The Museum of Egyptian Antiquities in Tahir

It exhibits a rare collection of over 250,000 genuine artifacts that date as far back as 5000 years, including an exclusive exhibit dedicated to the Tutankhamen - A collection of treasures, gold, and jewelry that were buried in his tomb for over 3,500 years before they were discovered in 1920 when his tomb was excavated.

If you wish to visit the mummies royal hall. You need to ask the tour guide to take the National Museum of Egyptian Civilization and you pay for this. It will cost 30 \$

The new Grand museum is not open yet. It will be open soon in 2022

Fly to Aswan Then you will be transferred to the hotel in Aswan- Basma hotel




Second Day :Day 2- ABu simble- Luxor

An early pick-up from your hotel in Aswan at 04: 00, travel by air-conditioned vehicle from Aswan to Abu Simbel, It takes 3 hours driving to the temples of Abu Simbel

Abu simble temples

The two temples were Carved out of the mountainside during the reign of Pharaoh Ramesses II in the 13th century BC, Upon arrival, Your Egyptologist guide will tell you all about one of the greatest and most whimsical pharaohs in Egyptian history. Marvel at the main façade of the Great Temple to Ramesses II and its 4 statues of the pharaoh seated on his throne following his advancing age. In theory, the main temple is dedicated to Amon-Re Horakhty and Ptah, but in practice, it was constructed for the greater glory of its builder, Ramses the Great. Continue to the smaller temple of Ramesses' consort, Queen Nefertari, situated right next to the Great Temple. Admire the impressive rock-cut façade depicting the pharaoh and his queen. Re-board the coach at 09:00 for the return transfer to Aswan before, visiting the High Dam, The Phila temple Lunch will be served in Aswan before you drive to [Luxor](#), Overnight in Steigenberger Nile Palace

[Karnak](#) Temple:

No site in Egypt is more impressive than [Karnak](#). It is the largest temple complex ever built by man and represents the combined achievement of many generations of ancient builders and pharaohs. The Temple of [Karnak](#) is actually three main temples, smaller enclosed temples, and several outer temples situated on 247 acres of land.

Lunch will be served in a local restaurant in [Luxor](#). Cross the Nile with a motorboat, Then Proceed to visit:

The Valley of kings:

[The Valley of Kings](#) is The final resting place of Egypt's rulers from the 18th to 20th dynasty, it is home to tombs including the great



pharaoh Ramses II and boy pharaoh Tutankhamen.

The tombs were well stocked with all the material goods a ruler might need in the next world. Most of the decoration inside the tombs is still well preserved.

[Hatshepsut](#) Temple:

It is one of the most beautiful & best preserved of all of the temples of Ancient Egypt. The temple was built on three levels with two wide ramps in a central position joining the levels together.

Colossi of Memnon:

Two massive stone statues of king Amenhotep III are the only remains of a complete mortuary temple.

The statues are made from blocks of quartzite sandstone which exist in [Cairo](#) then moved 700 KM to [Luxor](#)

At the end of your tour in [Luxor](#). you will be transferred to your hotel in [Marsa Alam](#). you will arrive at 18:30
