Everywhere you go here you find petrified sea shell and corals, Visit the Fossil & Climate Change Museum

The museum hosts a variety of whale fossils, and skeletons that are displayed outdoors, as the museum has a variety of fossils, skeletons, fossilized mangroves, and ancient seashells exhibited indoors in glass boxes, Enjoy your lunch. At around noon you will have lunch in a local restaurant in Luxor, Then Visit The Temple of Karnak -the largest ancient religious site known anywhere in the world:

Temple of Queen Hatshepsut

The Queen <u>Hatshepsut</u> temple is an Important Theban religious and funerary site on the west bank of the Nile, opposite <u>Luxor</u>, comprising temples and tombs dating from the early Middle Kingdom to the Ptolemaic period. The site consists of a deep bay in the Nebhepetra (Mentuhotep II).
