See how the ancient Egyptians how made the first Paper in History by Using the Papyrus Plant, if you like to buy real papyrus Gifts this will be the most suitable place

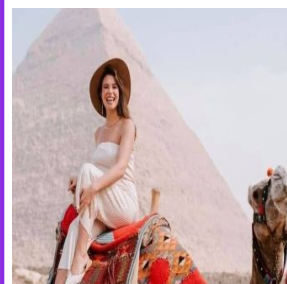


12:30 Lunch will be served during the Pyramids at the local restaurant in Giza
