Qarun lake

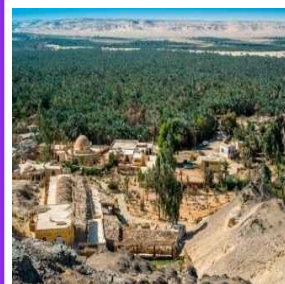
Named after the King who buried with all his gold and riches somewhere in the wadi.
