First Day : Day 1 Marsa Alam-luxor

Karnak Temple:

No site in Egypt is more impressive than Karnak. It is the largest temple complex ever built by man and represents the combined achievement of many generations of ancient builders and pharaohs. The Temple of <u>Karnak</u> is actually three main temples, smaller enclosed temples, and several outer temples situated on 247 acres of land.

Lunch will be served in a local restaurant in <u>Luxor</u>. Cross the Nile with a motorboat, Then Proceed to visit:

The Valley of kings:

The Valley of Kings is The final resting place of Egypt's rulers from the 18th to 20th dynasty, it is home to tombs including the great pharaoh Ramses II and boy pharaoh Tutankhamen.

he tombs were well stocked with all the material goods a ruler might need in the next world. Most of the decoration inside the tombs still well preserved.

Hatshepsut Temple:

It is one of the most beautiful & best preserved of all of the temples of Ancient Egypt. The temple was built on three levels with two wide ramps in a central position joining the levels together. Colossi of Memnon:

Two massive stone statues of king Amenhotep III are the only remains of a complete mortuary temple.

The statues are made from blocks of quartzite sandstone which exist in <u>Cairo</u> then moved 700 KM to <u>Luxor</u>

On the Evening you can enjoy An Optional Tour Sound and Light Show at Karnak: The show starts with a historical introduction covering the birth of the great city of Thebes and erection of the <u>Karnak</u> Temple. The show narrates the glorious achievements of some great Pharaohs as you listen to a magnificent and poetic description of the artistic treasures and great legacy which





the <u>Karnak</u> temple encloses. Overnight at Nile Palace <u>Luxor</u> Or Sonesta St George Hotel.

Second Day : Day 2: Luxor- Cairo - Marsa Alam

Early departure to Cairo from Luxor Via Egyptair at 05:50 from Luxor arrival Cairo at 07:00.First, you will visit the pyramids of Giza. <u>Cheops, Chephren & Mykerinus</u>. After seeing the famous pyramids you can head to visit <u>the Valley Temple</u>. While doing that you can have a closer look at the Great Sphinx - the legendary guardian that stands by the huge funeral complex with its lion body and the head of king Chephren.

Possibilities if the customer preferred to enter inside the great or the boat museum o the ing <u>Cheops</u>, But both tours are not included in the tour price Then continue your day tour to <u>Egyptian</u> <u>Museum</u> of antiquities. It displays the largest and most precious items of Egyptian art in the world.

It exhibits a rare collection of over 250,000 genuine artifacts that date as far back as 5000 years, including an exclusive exhibit dedicated to the Tutankhamen - A collection of treasures, gold, and jewelry that were buried in his tomb for over 3,500 years before they were discovered in 1920 when his tomb was excavated.

Then you will be Passing By Tahrir Square, where the Egyptian revolution began in 2011. Your tour finishes with a drop-off at your hotel.

at the end of your tour in Cairo, transfer to Cairo airport for depart to Hurghada, arrive Hurghada airport around 18:45, Then you will be transferred to your hotel in Marsa Alam.
